

Privacy Policy

This personal data policy indicates how Unitstaal A/S processes personal information about customers, suppliers and other external relations in relation to compliance with the Personal Data Regulation.

In general

Personal information is any kind of information that may be attributed to you to some extent. Such information may, for example, appear by access to our website, through inquiries or as a result of written correspondence. In general, we collect your contact details (such as your address, email address and telephone number) and information such as your job title. Occasionally, your personal information may be supplemented by information retrieved from other public sources.

Security

We have taken technical and organizational measures against the fact that your information is accidentally or illegally deleted, published, lost, impaired or comes to the knowledge of a person, misused or otherwise treated in violation of the law.

Temporary storage

We store the information for the time allowed by law and we delete them when they are no longer necessary. The period depends on the nature of the information and the background for storage. Thus, it is not possible to specify for how long the information will be retained.

Disclosure of information

Unitstaal does not disclose personal information to third parties unless required by law. Other disclosure of personal data such as name and e-mail, etc. will only happen if you consent to it.

In addition, we use a number of third part data processors to store and process data. They only deal with information on our behalf and are not allowed to use them for their own purposes. We only use data processors in countries that can provide your information with adequate protection.

Consent, insight and appeal

You are entitled to know what personal information we are processing about you. You may also object to the use of information at any time. You may also revoke your consent to processing information about you. If the information processed about you is incorrect, you are entitled to correct or delete. Please contact our office.
